

Costs

The costs of the international short courses can vary between **USD \$1.500** and **USD \$ 2.300** per week per student, for groups ranging from **10 to 20** people.

This includes:

- •Courses and academic services.
- •On campus: Wi-Fi, free hydration points.
- •Welcome lunch and farewell dinner.
